



## PETITION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE DCLG TO OVERTURN APPROVAL OF THE BISHOPTHORPE WIND FARM.

We the undersigned, consider that the Inspector and the Secretary of State in approving The Bishopthorpe Wind Farm nr Tetney Lincolnshire have been seriously mislead by ASC Renewables's Advocate at the Bishopthorpe Farm inquiry, (Appeal Ref: APP/D2510/A/14/2213150) regarding the outrageous assertion that legitimate opposition to this wind farm was **NOT** overwhelming. All 13 local Parish Councils registered their objection to this Dominating Over bearing application to form a 10 turbine large scale wind farm, along with 832 letters of objection from within the closest local communities.

The letters of support submitted by activists commissioned by the developer ASC Renewables, where predominately canvassed in Louth town centre miles away from the site and signed by persons not directly impacted by the wind farm.

We collectively wish to register a serious complaint to the Secretary of State DCLG, that we consider our concerns have NOT been given sufficient weight under the 'localism agenda' and therefore they appear to have been subverted and compromised.


